

NOTICES TO MARINERS

Safety Of Navigation

To: All Ports Users and shipping Companies, contractors and other concerned Parties

Abu Dhabi Ports Company (ADPC) reminds all port users that the Abu Dhabi Department of Transport Regulations (General and Port Operations), 2010, requires written authorization be secured from ADPC prior to undertaking any of the following works in or adjacent to ADPC port waters

- Placing or operating a light or day marker;
- Placing, altering, removing or relocating an aid to navigation buoy, mooring, float, picket mark or sign
- Building, placing, rebuilding, repairing, dredging, altering, moving or removing any structure or work on, in, over, under, through or across land or water

Any unauthorized development found within port waters is subject to immediate removal by ADPC. Alternatively, the Harbour Master may issue direction requiring removal of the unauthorized development within a timeframe as decided by the Harbour Master. In addition to reimbursing any costs incurred by ADPC, the person deemed responsible for the unauthorized development may be subject to a penalty or other sanction. Any person who fails to comply with a direction issued by the Harbour Master will, likewise, be liable to a penalty or other sanction.
