**To: All Vessels, Shipping Agents, Marine Services Provider,
and all other concerned parties**

Reference to Harbour Master Direction 01/2012 RE: Flags restricted from entering UAE Ports, and complying with the NTA Notification number OS/2011 for the same subject, no vessels under flags from countries (List 1) are allowed to enter Mina Zayed Port Limits, unless they are classed by any of the approved classification societies in (List 2).
