Minimum Tug Requirements for Musaffah Port

To: Port Users & Vessels' Agents

In order to ensure safety of navigation and protect AD PORTS infrastructures within Musaffah Port Limits, AD PORTS Musaffah Harbour Master requirements for use of AD PORTS Tugs within Musaffah Port, are detailed in the tables below.

Escort Tugs required for Channel transit

| Ship Specifications | Number of Assistant Tugs Required | Remarks |

| Vessels Less than 140 Meters LOA | No Tugs required | |
| Vessels from 140 up to 225 Meters LOA | One Tug required | AD PORTS sufficient approved Licensed Tug |
| Vessels more than 225 Meters LOA | Two Tugs required | AD PORTS sufficient approved Licensed Tug |
| Combination from 80 up to 140 Meters LOA | One Tug required | AD PORTS sufficient approved Licensed Tug |
| Combination from 140 up to 225 Meters LOA | Two Tugs required | AD PORTS sufficient approved Licensed Tug |
| Combination more than 225 Meters LOA | Three Tugs Required | AD PORTS sufficient approved Licensed Tug |
| Tankers less than 100 Meters LOA | No Tug Required | |
| Tankers from 100 to 170 Meters LOA | One tug required | AD PORTS sufficient approved Licensed Tug |
| Tankers more than 170 Meters LOA | Two Tugs required | AD PORTS sufficient approved Licensed Tug |
| Special type vessels such as warships, dredgers, special purpose vessels, oil | To be assessed on a case by case basis | Nominated duty pilot will be consulted |

Assistant Tugs required for Berthing / Un-Berthing:

| Ship Specifications | Number of Assistant Tugs Required | Remarks |
|---|---|--|
| All vessels less than 80 Meters LOA <u>Except Tanker</u> | - No Tug required - For Tankers Two Tugs Required | AD PORTS sufficient approved Licensed Tug |
| All vessels LOA 80 Meters and above without bow or stern thrusters | Two Tugs required | AD PORTS sufficient approved Licensed Tug |
| Vessels with LOA 80 Meters and above with <u>sufficient</u> bow or / and stern thrusters | One Tug required | AD PORTS sufficient approved Licensed Tug |
| Combination from 80 up to 140 meters LOA | One Tug required | AD PORTS sufficient approved Licensed Tug |
| Combination from 140 up to 225 meters LOA | Two Tugs required | AD PORTS sufficient approved Licensed Tug |
| Combination More than 225 Meters LOA | Three Tugs Required | AD PORTS sufficient approved Licensed Tug |
| Special type vessels such as warships, dredgers, special purpose vessels, oil rigs/platforms, ships exceeding certain displacement and/ or LOA etc. | To be assessed on a case by case basis | Nominated Duty Pilot will be consulted |
| Vessels shifting berths | To be assessed on a case by case basis | Nominated Duty Pilot will be consulted |

General Notes:

- 1. The above are the minimum requirements for safe maneuvering, berthing and/or un-berthing and Vessel Transit in the channel of the vessels within the Port limits.
- 2. The above requirements are based on normal weather and environmental conditions (winds, including forecast winds, of up to 20 knots). The pilot can request more Tugs assistance if he, with consultation of the Harbour Master, thinks it is needed for safe vessel movement within the Port.

- 3. Additional Tugs might be required during periods of adverse weather.
- 4. Due to considerable variations in vessel size, shape, condition and degree of capability, certain vessel movements are not adequately covered in above tables. They will be subject to HM decision.
- 5. The vessel Master has the right to request more than the above requirement if he feels the need to do so.
- 6. Assistant Tug doesn't mean the Main Tug of the combination.
- 7. Sufficient Tug will be accepted by the nominated duty pilot.
