

NOTICES TO MARINERS

ALL PORTS – ISSUE OF PERMIT(S) TO WORK To: All Ports Users, Agents and all other concerned parties

It is essential that anyone undertaking hazardous work demonstrates that they have followed an appropriate risk management process to identify and minimize any hazard associated with the proposed work aiming for safe completion of work for which A "Permit to work" (PTW) is issued.

It is mandatory to fulfill the requirements set out in the AD PORTS IHSEMS - PSS-HSE-400 PERMIT TO WORK SYSTEM procedure in order to execute effectively the issue and closeout of a PTW.

Permit Applicant shall apply for PTW for Marine activities to VTS, at least 24 hours prior to the commencement of the work.

Marine Permit to work is necessary for the following activities as a minimum,
